
SUMMARY ANALYSIS OF TOURIST ARRIVALS: APRIL 2017

TREND ANALYSIS: APRIL 2013 - APRIL 2017

A total of 919 084 tourist arrivals were recorded in April 2017, which was an increase of 15.5% (123 165) compared to the same month in 2016. The increase could also be related to Easter taking place in April this year while it was in March during 2015. Figure 1 below indicates tourist arrivals for the period April 2013 to April 2017. Tourist arrivals increased from 756 296 in 2013 to 840 100 in 2014, which was an increase of about 11.1%. Tourist arrivals however declined in April 2015 by 14.3% (120 543) compared to April 2014. Comparing April 2016 with April 2017, there was an increase in arrivals by 15.5% (123 165). April 2017 also recorded the highest number of tourist arrivals (919 084) when compared the same month of previous years under review.





APRIL 2017 COMPARED TO APRIL 2016 BY REGION

Table 1 below indicates tourist arrivals by region for April 2017 compared to the same month in 2016. All overseas regions recorded positive growths in tourist arrivals during the period under review except for Asia and Middle East which recorded declining growths of 3.1% and 8.0% respectively. Africa region recorded a growth of 14.8% during the same period under review which was driven by Africa land markets with a growth of 15.7% while Africa air declined by 5.3% during the same period. Africa continues to be the main source of tourist arrivals to the country accounting for more than 75% of total arrivals during this month.

JANUARY - APRIL 2017 COMPARED TO JANUARY - APRIL 2016

Arrivals for the period January-April 2017 compared to the same period in 2016 are indicated in Table 2 below. Tourist arrivals for the first four months of 2017 (3 541 299) recorded an increase of 0.7% compared to arrivals recorded during the same period in 2016 (3 516 924). Tourist arrivals from Africa decreased from 2 639 2684 in 2016 to 2 654 797 in 2017, which was a decline of about 2.8%. Total arrivals from overseas markets recorded a growth of 11.3% (98 930) during the same period under review. However, if arrivals continue to grow with a similar positive growth recorded in April 2017, arrivals for 2017 might grow with a healthy positive growth compared to 2016.

Table 3 gives rankings of top ten African source markets for the period January –April 2016 and January-April 2017. All top ten African markets remained at the same position for the period under review as indicated in the table above. Most countries recorded a declining growth in tourist arrivals except for Lesotho, Malawi and Angelo.


Table 4 below shows rankings of top ten overseas source markets for the same period under review. All top ten Overseas Source markets remained at the same position. During this period, most countries recorded an increase in tourist arrivals except for China which declined by 4 972 which is a 13.6% (4 972).
