
SUMMARY ANALYSIS OF TOURIST ARRIVALS: AUGUST 2017

TREND ANALYSIS: AUGUST 2013 - AUGUST 2017

A total of 852 339 tourist arrivals were recorded in August 2017, which was an increase of 2.2% (18 701) compared to the same month in 2016. Figure 1 below indicates tourist arrivals for the period August 2013 to August 2017. Tourist arrivals increased from 755 689 in 2013 to 828 531 in 2014, which was an increase of about 9.6%. Tourist arrivals however decreased in August 2015 by -11.7% (-97 283) compared to August 2014. Comparing August 2016 with August 2015, there was a significant increase in tourist arrivals by 14.0% (102 390), while August 2017 also increased by 2.2 % (18 701) when compared with the same month of previous year.





AUGUST 2017 COMPARED TO AUGUST 2016 BY REGION

Table 1 below indicates tourist arrivals by region for August 2017 compared to the same month in 2016. Most overseas regions recorded a positive growth in tourist arrivals during the period under review except for Asia. Africa indicated a growth of 1.4% and is the main source of tourist arrivals to the country accounting for about 74.9% (638 000) of total arrivals during this month.

JANUARY - AUGUST 2017 COMPARED TO JANUARY - AUGUST 2016

Arrivals for the period January-August 2017 compared to the same period in 2016 are indicated in Table 2 below. Tourist arrivals for the first eight months of 2017 (6 731 406) recorded an increase of 1.6% compared to arrivals recorded during the same period in 2016 (6 625 141). Tourist arrivals from Africa decreased from 5 043 294 in 2016 to 5 007 666 in 2017, which was a decline of about 0.7% (35 628). Total tourist arrivals from overseas grew by 9.0% (141 385) during the same period under review. Compared to other sub-regions, the Central and South America region had the highest growth of 85.3% (32 343) for the period under review.

Table 3 gives rankings of top ten African source markets for the period January-August 2016 and January-August 2017. All of the top ten African markets remained at the same position for the period under review. Most of the top ten countries recorded a declining growth in tourist arrivals except for Mozambique, Malawi and Angola for the period under review.

Table 4 below shows rankings of top ten overseas source markets for the same period under review. Comparing Jan-Aug 2017 with Jan-Aug 2016, Brazil recorded a significant growth of 113.2% (22 701) and moved from 16th position in 2016 to the 9th position in 2017. Australia moved higher as well from 7^{th} position in 2016 to 6^{th} position in 2017 recording a growth of 8.7% (5 896). China however dropped from the 6^{th} position in 2016 to 8^{th} position in 2017 with a declining growth of 18.1% (14 262).
