
# **SUMMARY ANALYSIS OF TOURIST ARRIVALS: JUNE 2017**

### TREND ANALYSIS: JUNE 2013 - JUNE 2017

A total of 708 978 tourist arrivals were recorded in June 2017, which was an increase of 2.5% (17 564) compared to the same month in 2016. Figure 1 below indicates tourist arrivals for the period June 2013 to June 2017. Tourist arrivals increased from 636 296 in 2013 to 672 726 in 2014, which was an increase of about 5.7%. Tourist arrivals however declined in June 2015 by 9.3% (62 634) compared to June 2014. Comparing June 2015 with June 2016, there was an increase in arrivals by 13.3% (81 322). June 2017 recorded the highest number of tourist arrivals (708 978) when compared the same month of previous years under review.

### JUNE 2017 COMPARED TO JUNE 2016 BY REGION

Table 1 below indicates tourist arrivals by region for June 2017 compared to the same month in 2016. Most overseas regions recorded positive growths in tourist arrivals during the period under review except for Asia which recorded a declining growth of 2.2%. The declining growth recorded in Asia was driven by China (including Hong Kong) which recorded a declining growth of 37% during the period under review. Brazil continues to drive the growth in Central and South America, with a growth of 176% recorded during June 2017 compared to the same month in 2016. The decline recorded in China as well as the growth recorded in Brazil will be further investigated. Africa continues to be the main source of tourist arrivals to the country accounting for about 78.5% of total arrivals during this month.

#### JANUARY - JUNE 2017 COMPARED TO JANUARY - JUNE 2016

Arrivals for the period January-June 2017 compared to the same period in 2016 are indicated in Table 2 below. Tourist arrivals for the first six months of 2017 (5 017 336) recorded an increase of 1.0% compared to arrivals recorded during the same period in 2016 (4 969 087). Tourist arrivals from Africa decreased from 3 793 492 in 2016 to 3 715 681 in 2017, which was a decline of about 2.1% (-77 811). Total tourist arrivals from overseas markets recorded a double digit growth of about 10.7% (125 676) during the same period under review. Compared to other sub-regions, the Central and South America region had the highest growth of 95.3% (26 092) for the period under review. As already indicated, this growth was driven by Brazil.

Table 3 gives rankings of top ten African source markets for the period January –June 2016 and January-June 2017. All top ten African markets remained at the same position for the period under review. Most of the top ten countries recorded a declining growth in tourist arrivals except for Malawi and Angola for the period under review.

Table 4 below shows rankings of top ten overseas source markets for the same period under review. Comparing Jan-June 2017 with Jan-June 2016, Brazil recorded the highest growth and this country moved from 17th position in 2016 to the 10th position in 2017 with a growth of about 128.5% (18 202). Australia moved higher from 8<sup>th</sup> position in 2016 to 6<sup>th</sup> position in 2017 recording a 9.5% increase (4 651) while the Netherlands also moved one position up from 6<sup>th</sup> place in 2016 to 5<sup>th</sup> position in 2017. China however dropped from 5<sup>th</sup> position in 2016 to 8<sup>th</sup> position in 2017 with a declining growth of 15.4% (-8 923). Switzerland fell out of the top ten countries during this period.
