

Tourism Employment (Jan-Mar 2018)

For the first quarter (Jan-Mar 2018), it is estimated that the tourism sector contributed about 740 583 jobs, which was about 4.5% of total employment in South Africa. This was an estimated increase of 3.7% compared to Quarter 1 of 2017.





SOUTH AFRICA TOURIST ARRIVALS PERFORMANCE: 2017


South African tourist arrivals increased by 2.4% in 2017 reaching a total of 10 285 197 million.

SOUTH AFRICA TOURISM GDP AND EMPLOYMENT CONTRIBUTION: 2016 (PROVISIONAL)

In 2016, it is estimated that tourism's direct contribution to GDP was R125, 136 million, which was about 2.9% of the total GDP.




SOUTH AFRICA INBOUND TOURISM KEY INDICATORS PERFORMANCE: 2017

Global tourist arrivals for 2017 was 1,322 million which was a 6.7% increase compared to 2016.
